

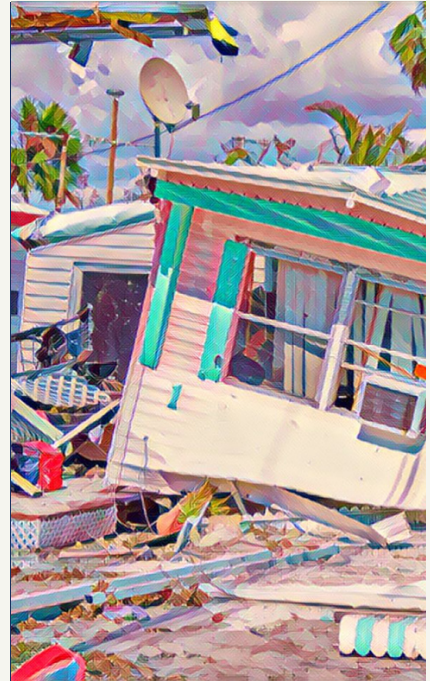

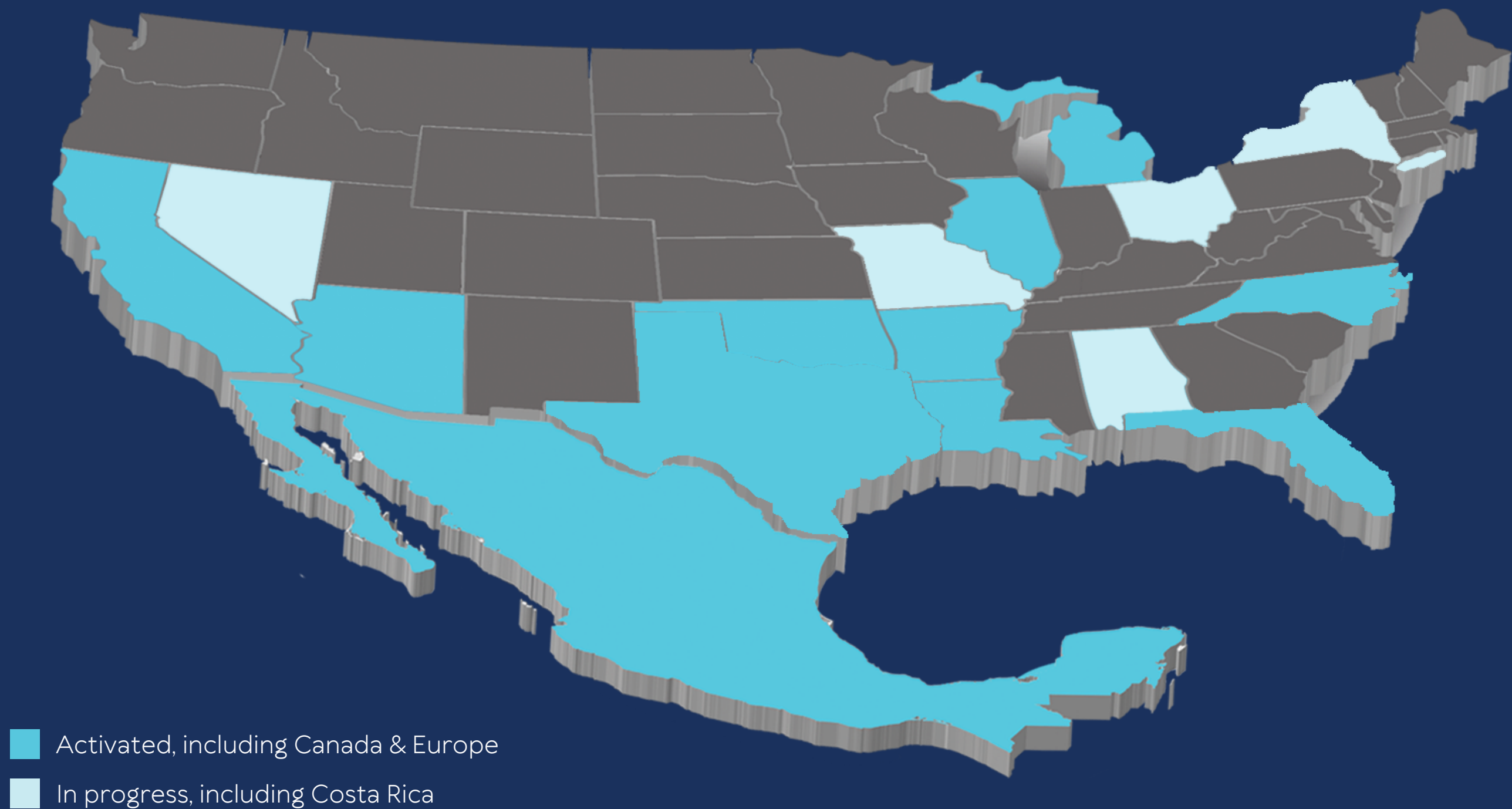

RESCUED AND CARED FOR

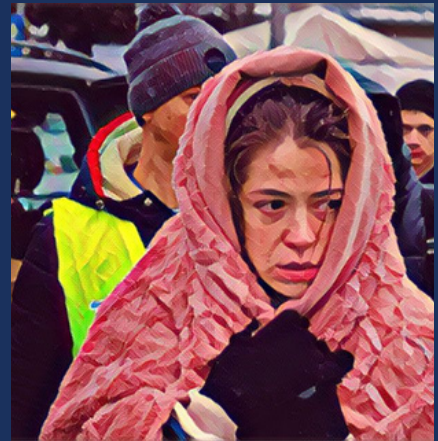

The people of Ukraine are weary, traumatized and in need of help and hope. Local churches in Ukraine and surrounding countries are on the frontlines of this grave and devastating crisis.

CityServe is resourcing these churches with food, emergency supplies, shelter, transportation, generators for heat and light, and emotional & spiritual support so they can rescue and care for the people of Ukraine.

HURRICANE IAN DISASTER RESPONSE

Resourced churches with emergency food, water and supplies to help families affected by the storm.

Hurricane Ian caused catastrophic damage to Florida. The devastation was widespread and families desperately needed help and hope. Several regions were without electricity and access to fresh water for several weeks. CityServe Florida's network of churches was already in place to provide a concentrated relief effort in the hardest hit regions of Southwest Florida, including Little Gasparilla Island.



CityServe Disaster Response Team and local churches are continuing to be resourced with emergency food and water • fuel for chainsaws, generators, and cars • generators • skid loader and trailer • specialty items such as hygiene kits, batteries and diapers • building supplies and tarps • freight for transportation of large items
